I. SUMMARY:

This bill revises membership requirements for the Boca Raton Airport Authority (authority). The revisions increase membership on the authority and require the Palm Beach County Board of Commissioners and the Boca Raton City Council to each appoint an additional member to the authority.

The fiscal impact is insignificant.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

The Boca Raton Airport Authority (authority) is an independent special district located in Palm Beach County. According to the *1998-1999 Official List of Special Districts*, the authority was created in 1982 by chapter 82-259, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 91-381, Laws of Florida.

The authority consists of five members. As a condition of eligibility for appointment, four members are required to reside within the city and one member must reside within the Greater Boca Raton Reserve Area. There is no requirement that a member must live within the municipality and west of the airport.

The county commission must appoint the member who resides in the Greater Boca Raton Reserve Area. The city council must appoint one member from a list of nominees of the Boca Raton Pilots Association, one member from the city council's own nominees, one member from the list of nominees of the Boca Raton Federation of Homeowners Associations, and one member from a list of nominees of the Boca Raton Chamber of Commerce.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

The bill increases the authority's membership to seven. It requires that four members reside within the municipality; two members must reside within the Greater Boca Raton Reserve Area; and one member must reside within the municipality and west of the airport.

The bill requires the board of county commissioners and the Boca Raton City Council to each appoint an additional member to the authority. The residential requirements of the city council appointees are revised so that the city council must appoint five members, four of whom must reside within the limits of the municipality and one of whom must reside within the limits of the municipality and west of the airport.

The addition of two members to the authority will cost the district \$2,400 for FY 1999-2000. This figure is based on the stipend cost for the additional members. The stipend is \$100 for each member per meeting attended. The stipend for all members is funded through user fees.
