**Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 4, between lines 19 and 20, of the bill

insert:

(b) A vasectomy may not be performed unless the person performing the vasectomy has given actual notice to the wife of the patient at least 48 hours prior to performing the vasectomy. However, a patient seeking a vasectomy may petition any circuit court for a waiver of the notice requirement. The petition shall include a statement that the patient has the ability to produce offspring, that he wishes to terminate that ability, and that notice to his wife could cause him serious physical or emotional harm.
