A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to correctional work programs;  
amending s. 946.515, F.S.; deleting the  
authority for PRIDE to contract with a  
political subdivision of the state to operate a  
fish and seafood processing plant; providing an  
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 946.515, Florida  
Statutes, 1998 Supplement, is amended to read:

946.515 Use of goods and services produced in  
correctional work programs.--

(3) Agricultural commodities, including, but not  
limited to, sugar cane, vegetables, beef, and dairy products,  
may be sold to private entities or may be sold or disposed of  
as provided in subsections (1) and (2). ~~The corporation may  
contract with any political subdivision of this state to  
operate a fish and seafood processing plant and to spawn and  
grow fish and seafood for sale as provided in this subsection.  
However, the corporation may not breed or sell live tropical  
fish.~~

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a  
law.
