21	approval or rejection at a referendum in conjunction with the
22	2000 presidential preference primary the question of whether
23	the district school board shall be composed of seven members,
24	each to be elected from a single-member residence area by
25	electors residing in the single-member residence area only,
26	notwithstanding the provisions of s. 230.061, s. 230.10, or s.
27	230.105, Florida Statutes.
28	(2) If the electors approve such election of district
29	school board members, the seven single-member residence areas
30	must be drawn by the district school board, and the district
31	school board shall provide for the orderly transition to such

election of district school board members as the terms of incumbent district school board members expire, beginning with the general election in November 2000. Section 2.
