A bill to be entitled
An act relating to education; creating s.
228.0563, F.S.; authorizing charter conversion
municipal subdistricts; providing requirements
for operation; providing for areas of municipal
jurisdiction; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 228.0563, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

228.0563 Charter conversion municipal
subdistricts.--Pursuant to s. 228.056, but notwithstanding s.
228.056(8)(h), upon compliance with s. 228.056(3), a
municipality or municipalities may present to the district
school board a school or group of schools to be operated by a
municipality. Unincorporated areas adjacent to incorporated
municipalities may be included in the area of municipal
jurisdiction for the purposes of this section if the governing
bodies of the municipalities and the county in which the area
is located agree on the boundaries of such additional areas.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN
COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SB 1640

Removed provisions that would have: (1) Required district
school boards to authorize charters requested by a
municipality or group of municipalities; (2) Permitted
municipally appointed charter school boards; and (3) Allowed a
municipality to unilaterally decide whether to request a
charter to operate schools in adjacent unincorporated areas.
