WHEREAS, as a new member of Congress, Representative Meek introduced legislation that subsequently passed Congress and was signed into law by the President to provide retirement security for household workers, and

WHEREAS, Congresswoman Meek played a significant role in providing over \$100 million in federal assistance to help rebuild Dade County after the devastation caused by Hurricane Andrew, and

WHEREAS, Representative Carrie Meek is a strong advocate for senior citizens, NOW, THEREFORE,
