As used in this subsection, the term "merchant" means an owner or operator, or the agent, consignee, employee, 18 19 lessee, or officer of an owner or operator, of any premises or 20 apparatus used for retail purchase or sale of any merchandise. 21 (2) Any merchant who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided 22 23 in section 775.082 or section 775.083, Florida Statutes.
