Subsection (1) of section 430.707, Florida 22 Statutes, 1998 Supplement, is amended to read: 23 430.707 Contracts.--24 25 (1) The department, in consultation with the agency, 26 shall select and contract with managed care organizations, and 27 with other qualified providers using the capitation 28 rate-setting method established under s. 430.704, to provide long-term care within community diversion pilot project areas. 29 30 Section 3.
