A bill to be entitled
An act relating to public records; amending s.
447.605, F.S.; providing for disclosure of
certain identifying information about a public
employee which is exempt from public records
requirements to the employee's certified
bargaining agent under certain conditions;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (4) is added to section 447.605,
Florida Statutes, to read:

447.605 Public meetings and records law; exemptions
and compliance.--

(4) An address, telephone number, or social security
number of a public employee which is otherwise exempt from
public records requirements by law must be disclosed to the
bargaining agent who is certified pursuant to this part to
represent that employee, upon written request by the
bargaining agent and submission of proof that the bargaining
agent is certified to represent that employee. The bargaining
agent must maintain the confidential status of any such
information and may use such information only for purposes
directly related to the bargaining agent's representation of
the public employee.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.
