department may develop a program for random drug testing, and randomly test persons as specified in subsection (2) and those persons who require certification under chapter 633 or chapter 943. These random tests are in addition to any other tests that are permitted under s. 112.0455. All other procedural safeguards, appellate rights, and provisions of s. 112.0455 apply. (4) The department may adopt rules, policies, and procedures necessary to administer this section. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. SENATE SUMMARY Authorizes the Department of Children and Family Services to provide random drug testing for certain employees in accordance with the Drug-Free Workplace Act.
