A bill to be entitled
An act relating to automatic teller machine
transaction surcharges; creating s. 655.966,
F.S.; prohibiting financial institutions from
imposing surcharges on transactions at certain
automatic teller machines; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 655.966, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

655.966 Automatic teller machine transaction surcharge
prohibition.--In the case of any electronic fund transfer that
is initiated by a consumer from an electronic terminal
operated by a person other than the financial institution
holding the account of the consumer and that uses a national
or regional communication network to effect the transaction
between such person and the financial institution holding the
account of the customer, no fee may be imposed on the consumer
with respect to such transaction by the person operating the
electronic terminal at which the transfer is initiated.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY

Prohibits financial institutions from imposing surcharges
for transactions at certain automatic teller machines.
