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          (6) With respect to a new business as defined in s.
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   196.012(15)(c), the taxing authority having jurisdiction to

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   to the public, or some other improvement that is dedicated to
   the development and exhibition of the performing or visual

           Section 3. The Legislature recognizes that the Central
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   Florida Theatre Alliance has been formed to promote the
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   theatrical arts within a 30-mile radius of Downtown Orlando
   and that it is dedicated to making Orlando a world-class
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   theater community. In recognition of the value of this
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   endeavor to the community and the state, the Legislature
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   declares the Central Florida Theatre Alliance to be the
   premier umbrella organization for the promotion of theater in
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   the Orlando area. Its goals of increasing the number of
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   productions, improving the size and education of theater
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   audiences, and promoting the awareness of theatrical
   opportunities in the Orlando area, and the number of theater
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   spaces, including a Downtown Orlando Theater District, are
