For purposes of this distinction, personnel 23 who provide curriculum development, consulting, and training 24 services for other personnel shall be considered 25 administrators with an instructional responsibility. 26 (2) Instructional personnel classifications, and <u>definitions</u> of <u>such</u> <u>c</u>lassifications, which differentiate 27 28 between personnel who have direct instructional contact with 29 students and evaluate student performance and personnel who provide services to students but do not directly evaluate 30 student performance.
