A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to the tax on diesel fuel;  
amending s. 206.8745, F.S.; providing for a  
refund of tax paid on undyed diesel fuel  
consumed by the engine of a motor coach during  
idle time for certain purposes; defining "motor  
coach"; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (8) is added to section  
206.8745, Florida Statutes, to read:

206.8745 Credits and refund claims.--

(8) Undyed, tax-paid diesel fuel consumed by the  
engine of a motor coach during idle time for the purpose of  
running climate control systems and maintaining electrical  
systems for the motor coach is subject to a refund as provided  
by rule. As used in this subsection, "motor coach" means a  
privately owned class 36 vehicle with a gross vehicle weight  
of 30,000 pounds or more, which is used exclusively in the  
commercial application of transporting passengers for  
compensation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999.
