II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message

House Amendment #1 allows school districts to receive a School Infrastructure Thrift (SIT) award for capital outlay savings realized through the operation of charter schools in non-district facilities during the 1996-1997, 1997-1998, 1998-1999, and 1999-2000 school years rather than indefinitely. SIT awards will be granted only for functional, frugal school construction after that.

House Amendment #2 corrects a scribner's error by renumbering subsections.

House Amendment #3 makes conforming changes in cross-references.

House Amendment #4 requires the Department of Education to adopt standards for long-termuse relocatable facilities by July 1, 2000, rather than July 1, 2003.
