The sign shall state in bold lettering 20 CITRUS CANKER SURVEY IN PROGRESS." 21 If after the survey is completed the department 22 (3) suspects that citrus canker is present, a department plant 23 pathologist must inspect the suspect property and conduct a 24 visual diagnosis. Upon determination of a citrus canker 25 positive or exposed host tree, the department shall notify the 26 27 property owners or their authorized representatives, in writing, of the action to be taken. Such notice must be in the 28 form of an immediate final order and must be delivered to the 29 30 property owner within 30 working days after diagnosis.
