(1) The Division of Children's Medical Services of the Department of Health shall contract with a 23 private nonprofit provider affiliated with a teaching hospital 24 to conduct clinical trials, approved by a federally sanctioned 25 26 institutional review board within the teaching hospital, on 27 the use of the drug Secretin to treat autism. 28 (2) The private nonprofit provider shall report its 29 findings to the Division of Children's Medical Services, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 30 Representatives, and other appropriate bodies. 31
