The council shall staff the task force as necessary. The members of the task force shall 13 serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for 14 15 reasonable and necessary expenses of attending the summit and performing duties of the task force, including per diem and 16 17 travel expenses as provided in s. 112.061. Such expenses shall 18 be reimbursed from funds of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.
