Funds to be credited to the trust fund 21 shall consist of funds disbursed, by nonoperating transfer, 22 23 from the Department of Banking and Finance Tobacco Settlement 24 Clearing Trust Fund in amounts equal to the annual appropriations made from this trust fund. 25 26 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and

pursuant to s. 216.351, any unencumbered balance in the trust

fund at the end of any fiscal year and any encumbered balance remaining undisbursed on December 31 of the same calendar year

shall revert to the Department of Banking and Finance Tobacco

Settlement Clearing Trust Fund.
