(1) The Florida Organ and Tissue Donor 28 Education and Procurement Trust Fund, FLAIR number 68-2-509, 29 which was created within the Agency for Health Care 30 Administration by chapter 95-316, Laws of Florida, and assigned to section 732.92155, Florida Statutes, and which is 31 1

to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on July 1, 1999, is re-created. (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. б Section 2. Section 2 of chapter 95-316, Laws of Florida, is repealed. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999. HOUSE SUMMARY Re-creates the Florida Organ and Tissue Donor Education and Procurement Trust Fund within the Agency for Health Care Administration.
