(14) For the purposes of ranking and selecting projects for funding pursuant to paragraph (3)(a) the Acquisition and Restoration Commission shall ensure that each water management district receives the following percentage of funds annually:

(a) 35 percent to the South Florida Water Management District.

(b) 25 percent to the Southwest Florida Water Management District.

(c) 25 percent to the St. John's River Water Management District.

(d) 7.5 percent to the Suwannee River Water Management District.

(e) 7.5 percent to the Northwest Florida Water

2 (15) It is the intent of the Legislature that in  
3 developing the list of projects for funding pursuant to  
4 paragraph (3)(a), that these funds not be used to abrogate the  
5 financial responsibility of those point and nonpoint sources  
6 that have contributed to the degradation of water or land  
7 areas. Therefore an increased priority shall be given by the  
8 Acquisition and Restoration Commission to those projects that  
9 have secured a cost-sharing agreement allocating  
10 responsibility for the cleanup of point and nonpoint sources.
