Section 10. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Management Services to fund the administrative costs to establish and implement an Internet site for the One-Stop Permitting System.

Section 11. Effectively July 1, 1999, the sum of \$3 million is appropriated from nonrecurring general revenue to the Executive Branch Administered Funds to be used to offset the potential decline in revenues as a result of the expedited One-Stop Permitting System. The funds shall be held in reserve by the Executive Office of the Governor until the principals of the Revenue Estimating Conference have determined the amount of loss of permit fees associated with applications submitted pursuant to the one-stop permitting

 2 spending plan based on an analysis provided by the Revenue
