(4) Pursuant to the provisions of s. 19(f)(2), Art. 20 III of the State Constitution, the Off-Highway Vehicle 21 Revolving Trust Fund, unless terminated sooner, shall be 22 terminated on July 1, 2003. However, prior to its scheduled 23 24 termination, the Off-Highway Vehicle Revolving Trust Fund 25 shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2). Section 2.
