(1) This section may be cited as the 14 Florida Maximum Class Size Construction Program. 15 16 (2) In addition to any other state funds, funds shall 17 be made available to school districts with the 100 lowest-achieving schools for grades K-3, to construct 18 19 additional student stations to the extent that funds are 20 appropriated for this purpose in the General Appropriations Act to attain a class size of 1 full-time-equivalent teacher 21 22 to 15 pupils. (3) The Department of Education shall adopt rules 23 pertaining to this program, including achievement standards to 24 25 identify such schools, construction specifications and appropriate bidding conditions, amount of award, and district 26 27 data-reporting requirements regarding class size. 28 (4) Districts receiving funds under this program shall 29 maintain class size in grades K-3 in eligible schools at a 30 ratio of 1 full-time-equivalent teacher to 15 pupils for at

construction funds received under this program to the Department of Education. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999.
