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A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to medical necessity; creating  
ss. 627.6015, 627.6511, 636.0035, 641.195,  
641.4025, and 641.475, F.S.; construing  
treatments or medications requested or  
prescribed by a licensed physician to be  
medically necessary for certain purposes;  
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Sections 627.6015, 627.6511, 636.0035,  
641.195, 641.4025, and 641.475, Florida Statutes, are created  
to read:

627.6015 Medical necessity.--Notwithstanding any other  
provision of this part, any treatment or medication requested  
or prescribed by a licensed physician for a patient under the  
physician's care shall be deemed to be medically necessary for  
purposes of this part.

627.6511 Medical necessity.--Notwithstanding any other  
provision of this part, any treatment or medication requested  
or prescribed by a licensed physician for a patient under the  
physician's care shall be deemed to be medically necessary for  
purposes of this part.

636.0035 Medical necessity.--Notwithstanding any other  
provision of this part, any treatment or medication requested  
or prescribed by a licensed physician for a patient under the  
physician's care shall be deemed to be medically necessary for  
purposes of this part.

641.195 Medical necessity.--Notwithstanding any other  
provision of this part, any treatment or medication requested

1 or prescribed by a licensed physician for a patient under the  
2 physician's care shall be deemed to be medically necessary for  
3 purposes of this part.

4 641.4025 Medical necessity.--Notwithstanding any other  
5 provision of this part, any treatment or medication requested  
6 or prescribed by a licensed physician for a patient under the  
7 physician's care shall be deemed to be medically necessary for  
8 purposes of this part.

9 641.475 Medical necessity.--Notwithstanding any other  
10 provision of this part, any treatment or medication requested  
11 or prescribed by a licensed physician for a patient under the  
12 physician's care shall be deemed to be medically necessary for  
13 purposes of this part.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a  
15 law.
