There is hereby created a six-member 12 Clinical Nutrition Study Committee appointed by the Secretary 13 of Health. Members of the committee shall include a representative from the Department of Health, a member of the 14 Dietetics and Nutrition Practice Council, two persons licensed 15 as nutrition counselors, a member of the Florida Association 16 17 of Dietitians, and a consumer 60 years of age or older. The study committee shall provide a report to the President of the 18 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the 19 20 chairs of the appropriate substantive committees of the Legislature no later than January 1, 2000, which shall include 21 a study of the educational, experience, and training 22 requirements for a person to be licensed as a clinical 23 nutritionist or as a nutrition counselor.
