26	<u>facility pursuant to chapter 395. The department shall inspect</u>		
27	<u>the physician's office annually unless the office is</u>		
28	<u>accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or an</u>		
29	<u>accrediting organization subsequently approved by the Board of</u>		
30	<u>Medicine. The actual costs for registration and inspection or</u>		
31	<u>accreditation shall be paid by the person seeking to register</u>
