Statewide HIV and AIDS prevention 6 campaign. --7 (1) The Department of Health shall develop and implement a statewide HIV and AIDS prevention campaign that is 8 directed towards minorities who are at risk of HIV infection. 9 10 The campaign shall include television, radio, and outdoor advertising; public service announcements; and peer-to-peer 11 12 outreach. Each campaign message and concept shall be evaluated with members of the target group to ensure its effectiveness. 13 The campaign shall provide information on the risk of HIV and 14 15 AIDS infection and strategies to follow for prevention, early detection, and treatment. The campaign shall use culturally 16 17 sensitive literature and educational materials and promote the development of individual skills for behavior modification. 18 19 (2) The Department of Health shall establish four positions within the department for HIV and AIDS regional 20 21 minority coordinators and one position for a statewide HIV and AIDS minority coordinator.
