This exemption is allowed only if the association is 26 designated a National Park Service Cooperating Association by 27 the United States Department of the Interior and holds a 28 current exemption from federal corporate income tax pursuant 29 to s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. 30 31
