A bill to be entitled
An act relating to historical preservation;
providing legislative findings with respect to
the ownership of Hialeah Park, located in
Hialeah, Florida; providing that it is in the
public's best interest that the park be owned
by the state or a municipality; repealing s.
550.72, F.S., relating to a study of Hialeah
Park; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other law, the
Legislature finds that, pursuant to a study conducted by the
Department of State and the Office of the Mayor of the City of
Hialeah, it is in the best interest of the public that Hialeah
Park, located in Hialeah, Florida, be owned by the state or a
municipality in order to conserve the acreage of the park and
preserve its historical and recreational significance.

Section 2. Section 550.72, Florida Statutes, as
created by section 12 of chapter 98-190, Laws of Florida, is
repealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.
