A state agency may not promote unnecessary construction by awarding bonus points for new construction 16 17 when the redevelopment or renovation of existing structures or facilities would serve the purpose or attain the goals of the 18 19 program in question. Further, when practicable, bonus points 20 must be awarded for redevelopment or reuse of existing structures or facilities. 21 22 Section 2.
