Section 20.3254, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 20.3254 Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission; Grants and Donations Trust Fund. --(1) The Grants and Donations Trust Fund is created within the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. The fund shall serve as the depository for any moneys received by the commission which are not otherwise deposited directly into a separate trust fund, including, but not limited to, federal grants and other grants, receipts, gifts, or donations made to the commission. The trust fund is intended to be a broad-based fund from which moneys may be used for various program purposes of the commission, including purposes for which federal funds were intended. (2) Funds from the trust fund may be expended for purposes related to marine research, marine habitat restoration, aquatic weed control, aquatic life, wild animal
