A bill to be entitled
An act relating to telephone solicitation;
amending s. 501.059, F.S.; prohibiting
telephone solicitors from making unsolicited
calls without complete caller identification
information; providing penalties; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (11) is added to Section
501.059, Florida Statutes, to read:

501.059 Telephone solicitation.--

(11) It is the intent of the Legislature to protect
consumers from unwanted telephone solicitations and afford
consumers all possible information regarding the identity of
any telephone solicitor who places a call to that consumer. A
telephone solicitor may not make or cause to be made any
unsolicited telephonic sales call to any residential, mobile,
or telephonic paging device telephone number unless all
possible caller identification information is provided.

(a) Failure to comply with this subsection is an
unfair and deceptive trade practice, punishable under the
provisions of part II of this chapter.

(b) Any telephone solicitor who knowingly violates
this subsection commits a misdemeanor of the first degree,
punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. For the
purposes of this subsection, the following actions constitute
a knowing violation:

1. Disabling a telephone system's caller
indentification generator;

- 2. Providing a false or fictitious number;
- 3. Knowingly using telephone equipment that is incapable of providing caller identification information; or
- 4. Knowingly using a telephone carrier that is incapable of passing on caller identification information to the intended recipient of the telephone solicitation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 1999.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides penalties for a telephone solicitor who makes unsolicited calls without providing all possible caller identification information.
