A bill to be entitled
An act relating to the Fish and Wildlife
Conservation Commission; creating s. 372.5711,
F.S.; directing the commission to adopt certain
permit or license fees and a processing charge
by rule; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 372.5711, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

372.5711 License and permit fees established by the
commission.--Notwithstanding any other provision of this
chapter, all license and permit fees established by this
chapter, except for license and permit fees established in s.
372.57, shall be established by the Fish and Wildlife
Conservation Commission by rule. Any permit or license fee
adopted by rule supersedes and replaces the fee provided for
in this chapter. In addition, the commission may adopt by rule
a processing charge of up to \$100 for each license or permit
required by chapter 39, Florida Administrative Code. The
commission shall annually report to the legislature any
actions taken under this section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

SENATE SUMMARY

Directs the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission to
adopt certain permit and license fees and a processing
