A bill to be entitled
An act relating to class size; amending s. 236.687, F.S., requiring the Legislature to annually appropriate to the Department of Education an amount sufficient to reduce the class size of all kindergarten through grade three classes to twenty students per full-time equivalent teacher; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (1) and (4) of section 236.687, Florida Statutes, 1998 Supplement, are amended to read: 236.687 Florida Maximum Class Size Study Act.--
(1) This section may be cited as the "Florida Maximum Class Size study Act."
(4) Beginning with school year 1998-1999, it shall be the goal of the Legislature and each school district that each elementary school in the school district beginning with kindergarten through grade three class sizes not exceed 20 students, with a ratio of one full-time equivalent teacher per 20 students; except that only in the case of critically low-performing schools as identified by the Commissioner of Education, the goal in kindergarten through grade three shall be a ratio of one full-time equivalent teacher per 15 students. Beginning with the 1999-2000 fiscal year, the Legislature shall annually appropriate to the Department of Education an amount from the General Revenue Fund sufficient to reduce the class size of all kindergarten through grade three classes to twenty students per full-time equivalent
