The ordinance shall provide for the board of county commissioners 18 19 to administer the funds or shall designate local safety groups 20 to receive and administer the funds. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 21 22 law, but it shall not take effect unless it is enacted by at least a three-fifths vote of the membership of each house of 23 24 the Legislature. 25 26 27 SENATE SUMMARY Authorizes a board of county commissioners to adopt an ordinance requiring that \$2 be withheld from each civil penalty paid to the county.
