Subsection (1) of section 827.03, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 18 19 827.03 Abuse, aggravated abuse, and neglect of a 20 child; penalties .--(1) "Child abuse" means: 21 22 (a) Intentional infliction of physical or mental 23 injury upon a child; (b) Any act of domestic violence, as defined in s. 24 25 25.385, which is committed by a caregiver in the presence of a child; 26 27 (c) (b) An intentional act that could reasonably be 28 expected to result in physical or mental injury to a child; or 29 (d)(c) Active encouragement of any person to commit an 30 act that results or could reasonably be expected to result in 31 physical or mental injury to a child.

A person who knowingly or willfully abuses a child without causing great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement to the child commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. Section 2. Section 827.035, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 827.035 Death of a child resulting from physical abuse. -- Notwithstanding any other law, if a child dies as a direct result of any act of physical abuse committed against the child by the child's parent, legal guardian, or caregiver, the parent, legal guardian, or caregiver shall be sentenced to death or life imprisonment. Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 1999. SENATE SUMMARY Provides that the offense of child abuse includes an act of domestic violence if the act is committed in the presence of a minor child.
