A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to orthotics, prosthetics, and  
pedorthics; allowing a person who met the  
experience requirement to practice orthotics,  
prosthetics, or pedorthics before a specified  
date to apply for licensure, based on the  
person's experience and educational  
preparation, without meeting the educational  
requirements set forth in statute; providing an  
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Any person who met the period of experience  
requirement set forth in section 468.805(1), Florida Statutes,  
prior to March 1, 1998, may apply for licensure pursuant to  
section 468.805(1), Florida Statutes, prior to July 1, 1999.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a  
law.

LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY

Allows a person who met the experience requirements to  
practice orthotics, prosthetics, or pedorthics prior to  
March 1, 1998, to apply for licensure, based on the  
person's experience and educational preparation, without
