A bill to be entitled
An act relating to pupil and student records
and reports; amending s. 228.093, F.S.;
providing that this section does not prohibit
the disclosure of certain disciplinary records
containing information that personally
identifies a student who has committed a crime
of violence; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (7) is added to section 228.093,
Florida Statutes, to read:

228.093 Pupil and student records and reports; rights
of parents, guardians, pupils, and students; notification;
penalty.--

(7) This section does not prohibit any postsecondary
educational agency or institution from disclosing disciplinary
records containing information that personally identifies a
student or students who have either admitted to or been found
to have committed any act that is a crime of violence which is
in violation of institutional policy and consists either of a
violation of the law or of a specific institutional policy, if
the records are directly related to such misconduct.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

SENATE SUMMARY
