On page 3, lines 4 through 11,
remove from the bill: all said lines

and insert in lieu thereof: facility to knowingly, on two or more occasions, violate a posted jail rule governing the conduct of prisoners, if the rule prohibits any of the following acts:

(a) Assaulting any person;

(b) Fighting with another person;

(c) Threatening another with bodily harm, or any offense against another person or property;

(d) Extortion, blackmail, protection, demanding or receiving money or anything of value in return for protection against others to avoid bodily harm, or under threat of informing;

(e) Engaging in sexual acts with others;

(f) Making sexual proposals or threats to another;

(g) Indecent exposure;
