Senator Hargrett moved the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 4, line 24, after the period

insert: The Governor shall appoint a liaison from a state agency to assist with each proposal and their implementation. These liaisons shall have the full assistance of the Executive Office of the Governor, the agencies of state government, and their employees. If a state employee is not able to assist a liaison because of state law or regulation, the liaison shall notify the Governor, the Office of Urban Opportunity, and the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability concerning the impasse and prepare proposals to resolve them. Upon a written request of a liaison, the Governor may by executive order or emergency rule address regulatory or procedural impasses to enable prompt implementation of a community's proposal. Any federal TANF funding appropriated by the state to benefit WAGES participants, to assist needy families, or to promote job placement and employment retention of WAGES participants that
