20	<u>(5)(a) The governing authority of any municipality</u>		
21	<u>with a resident population of 300,000 or more on April 1,</u>		
22	<u>1999, and which has been declared in a state of financial</u>		
23	<u>emergency pursuant to this section within the previous 2</u>		
24	<u>fiscal years may impose a discretionary per-vehicle surcharge</u>		
25	<u>of up to 20 percent on the gross revenues of the sale, lease,</u>		
26	<u>or rental of space at parking facilities within the</u>		
27	<u>municipality that are open for use to the general public.</u>		
28	<u>(b) A municipal governing authority that imposes the</u>		
29	<u>surcharge authorized by this subsection may use the proceeds</u>		
30	<u>of such surcharge for the following purposes only:</u>		
31	<u>1. No more than 80 percent of the surcharge proceeds</u>

1 shall be used by the governing authority to reduce its ad
2 valorem tax millage rate or to reduce or eliminate non-ad
3 valorem assessments.

4 2. A portion of the balance of the surcharge proceeds
5 shall be used by the governing authority to increase its
6 budget reserves; however, the governing authority shall not
7 reduce the amount it allocates for budget reserves from other
8 sources below the amount allocated for reserves in the fiscal
9 year prior to the year in which the surcharge is initially
10 imposed. When a 15 percent budget reserve is achieved, based
11 on the average gross revenue for the most recent 3 prior
12 fiscal years, the remaining proceeds from this subparagraph
13 shall be used for the payment of annual debt service related
14 to outstanding obligations backed or secured by a covenant to
15 budget and appropriate from non-ad valorem revenues.

16 (c) This subsection is repealed on June 30, 2006.
