The funds must be distributed by the department to each sponsoring designee 21 22 within the state which was announced in January 1999, the 23 Federal Empowerment Zone designation under 26 U.S.C. s. 24 1391(g) or to each community that was awarded in January 1999 25 the Rural Enterprise Community designation, except that the Department of Community Affairs may retain up to 2 percent of 26 27 the annual appropriation for state administrative costs 28 associated with the program. From those funds, at least \$4.9 29 million but no more than \$5 million must be distributed to an 30 urban sponsoring designee and at least \$245,000 but no more 31 than \$250,000 must be distributed to a rural sponsoring 1 File original & 9 copies hca0012

7	law and meeting the local-match requirements imposed by the
8	Federal Empowerment or Enterprise Community regulations and
