A student, and the viewing of pictures or motion pictures that teach about 18 disease, conflict with the religious teachings of the child's 19 20 religious affiliation, is exempt from such instruction; and a 21 child so exempted may not be penalized by reason of that 22 exemption. Course descriptions for comprehensive health education shall not interfere with the local determination of 23 appropriate curriculum which reflects local values and 24 25 concerns. 26 Section 2.
