(2) It is the duty of the person responsible for the 23 administration of such auditorium to provide a suitable flag 24 25 and cause it to be displayed in the manner provided in subsection (1). If any such person willfully fails to cause 26 27 the flag to be so displayed, such person is guilty of a 28 noncriminal violation, punishable as provided in s. 775.083.

(3) It is unlawful for any person to willfully remove

or cause the removal of any flag displayed pursuant to

subsection (1), except for the cleaning, repair, or

replacement of such flag. A person who violates the provisions of this subsection commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. HOUSE SUMMARY Prohibits the willful removal of a United States flag displayed as provided by law from a publicly supported and controlled auditorium. Provides exceptions. Provides a second degree misdemeanor penalty for violation.
