(d) Any place or building used By a criminal street gang for the purpose of conducting a pattern of criminal street gang activity as defined by s. 874.03; or (e) On more than two occasions within a six-month period, as the site of a violation of s. 812.019 relating to dealing in stolen property may be declared to be a public nuisance, and such nuisance may be abated pursuant to the procedures provided in this section. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999.
