Subsection (2) of section 627.4236, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 12 13 627.4236 Coverage for bone marrow transplant 14 procedures.--15 (2) An insurer or a health maintenance organization 16 may not exclude coverage for bone marrow transplant procedures 17 recommended by the referring physician and the treating 18 physician under a policy exclusion for experimental, clinical 19 investigative, educational, or similar procedures contained in 20 any individual or group health insurance policy or health 21 maintenance organization contract issued, amended, delivered, 22 or renewed in this state that covers treatment for cancer, if the particular use of the bone marrow transplant procedure is 23 determined to be accepted within the appropriate oncological 24 25 specialty and not experimental pursuant to subsection (3). Covered bone-marrow-transplant procedures must include costs 26 associated with the donor-patient to the same extent and 27 28 limitations as costs associated with the insured. 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999. 30 31
