Section 5. Section 239.514, Florida Statutes, 1998 Supplement, is amended to read:

239.514 Workforce Development Capitalization Incentive Grant Program.--The Legislature recognizes that the need for school districts and community colleges to be able to respond to emerging local or statewide economic development needs is critical to the workforce development system. The Workforce Development Capitalization Incentive Grant Program is created to provide grants to school districts and community colleges on a competitive basis to fund some or all of the costs associated with the creation or expansion of workforce development programs that serve specific employment workforce needs. Funds may also be used to upgrade workforce development programs to established industry standards in accordance with program updates conducted by the Division of Community

1 Colleges or the Division of Workforce Development.

2 (1) Funds awarded for a workforce development
3 capitalization incentive grant may be used for instructional
4 equipment, laboratory equipment, supplies, personnel, student
5 services, or other expenses associated with the creation,

7 Expansion of a program may include either the expansion of
8 enrollments in a program or expansion into new areas of
9 specialization within a program. No grant funds may be used
