2 An act relating to the re-creation of the
3 Incidental Trust Fund within the Department of
4 Agriculture and Consumer Services without
5 modification; re-creating the Incidental Trust
6 Fund; carrying forward current balances and
7 continuing current sources and uses thereof;
8 providing an effective date.

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10 WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of
11 the Incidental Trust Fund, which is otherwise scheduled to be
12 terminated pursuant to constitutional mandate, and

13 WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the Incidental
14 Trust Fund before its scheduled termination date and has found
15 that it continues to meet an important public purpose, and

16 WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public
17 policy concerning the Incidental Trust Fund sets adequate
18 parameters for its use, NOW, THEREFORE,

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20 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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22 Section 1. (1) The Incidental Trust Fund, FLAIR
23 number 42-2-381, which was created within the Department of
24 Agriculture and Consumer Services and which is to be
25 terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State
26 Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created.

27 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried
28 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund
29 are continued.

30 Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4,
31 2000.
