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A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to the re-creation of the  
Citrus Inspection Trust Fund without  
modification; re-creating the Citrus Inspection  
Trust Fund; carrying forward current balances  
and continuing current sources and uses  
thereof; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of  
the Citrus Inspection Trust Fund, which is otherwise scheduled  
to be terminated pursuant to constitutional mandate, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the Citrus  
Inspection Trust Fund before its scheduled termination date  
and has found that it continues to meet an important public  
purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public  
policy concerning the Citrus Inspection Trust Fund sets  
adequate parameters for its use, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The Citrus Inspection Trust Fund,  
FLAIR number 42-2-093, which was created within the Department  
of Agriculture and Consumer Services and which is to be  
terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State  
Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created.

(2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried  
forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund  
are continued.

Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4,  
2000.
